

## Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium @ The Harbour School Report April 2019

Funding allocation for the current academic year:

- £6k

How we intend to spend our allocation in 2019/2020:

- Numeracy resources for more abstract aspects of maths. Concrete resources for consolidation to close identified gaps in early stage fundamentals.
- Purchase of additional reading books and other materials with appropriate levels of reading ability and linked to interests/curriculum of our Yr7 pupils.
- Targeted 1:1 support from Pupil Support Staff.
- Phonics training for key staff.
- Precision Teaching training for key staff

How we spent our previous year's allocation (2018/2019):

- Targeted 1:1 support from Pupil Support Staff
- Purchase of practical maths resources including multilink, 2D/3D shapes, measure sticks, calculators and place value resources.
- Subscription to Kangaroo maths

How last year's allocation made a difference to the attainment of the pupils who benefit from the funding:

- The majority of Yr7 learners are making expected progress in English and maths and significant proportions are making better than expected progress in both English and maths (see table below).
